



Snow-capped Summits!

This curriculum map provides an overview of what your child will be learning across the curriculum this half term.

Wherever possible learning will be linked to our focus topic.



In Year 4 as readers and writers, we will be reading 'Blue John' by Berlie Doherty. We will be building reading stamina and focusing on questions based on the VIPER skills.

We will focus on using conjunctions, organising paragraphs around a theme and using a variety of verb forms. We will use these skills to write a non-fiction letter.

As mathematicians, we will be developing our understanding of time, specifically looking at converting analogue and digital time.

As well as this, we will be learning about properties of shape and position and direction. Within these lessons, we will explore our problem solving and reasoning skills.

As scientists, we will find out about electrical circuits, conductors and insulators.

As geographers, we will be using maps to build knowledge of the wider world and the UK, exploring the points of the compass. We will be looking at rivers, valleys and mountains.

Our topic in French is 'Au salon de thé'. We will be learning about food and drink items we might find in a French café.

In RE, we will be thinking and learning about the question: 'Why is there so much diversity of belief within...?'.

In Learning for Life, we will be learning about drugs, alcohol and tobacco. We will also be doing some basic first aid.

As musicians, we will be exploring the topics: Singing Spanish and Building.

In computing, we will be learning how to use repetition in games within the programme - Scratch.

In PE, we will developing our striking, fielding and co-ordination skills whilst participating in tennis and cricket lessons.

As artists, will we be exploring and creating work in the style of Georgia O'Keefe.

In online safety, we will be looking at: health, wellbeing and lifestyle as well as privacy and security and copyright and ownership.
