Key facts / Knowledge:

- We are part of a global community.
- The culture of a group of people is the behaviour, thoughts and actions that they show every day.
- In our school, we have a culture of being kind and respectful.
- People around the world may have different views and opinions because they come from a different culture.
- Diversity is about including people from different cultures.
- There are lots of countries in the world; some are hotter, and some are colder.
- Food, animals, homes and daily life may be similar or different for children around the world.
- A globe is a model of the Earth.
- A map is a picture or drawing of an area of land or sea.
- There are many different habitats around the world including woodland, desert, jungle, savannah.
- Africa is a continent with lots of countries, including Kenya, Tanzania, Egypt and Ghana.
- The savannah is a mixed grass and woodland habitat.
- The world's largest savannah is in Tanzania, Africa – It is called The Serengeti.
